



- 1. Communication and Leadership Skills Development
- 2. Exposure to the Legislative Process (Federal, State & Local)
- 3. Practical Work Experience
- 4. Opportunity to Work with Legislators to Help Our Community
- 5. Opportunity to get Recommendation Letter for Future College and/or Job application

#### **Qualifications:**

- 1. Chinese American, 16 years or older as of June 1, 2014.
- 2. High school Junior or Senior student.
- 3. Resident of the East Bay, Tri-City Area.
- 4. Members of CBC preferred. Priority consideration will be based on seniority of CBC membership.
- 5. CBC Toastmaster Youth Leadership Program experience preferred.

#### Requirements:

- 1. Must be able to work 3 to 6 hours a week (total of at least 60 hours during summer).
- 2. Must be able to make 3 5 month commitment (to be negotiated with local government agencies or legislative offices).
- 3. Must write an essay describing your experience at the end of the internship.
- 4. Must attend the interview process in mid-April 2014 (place TBD).
- 5. Must be able to take one Saturday (half day) training class in Fremont; date to be determined (between 5/1/14 to 6/7/14). CBC will pay for the training expense.
- Must be available to meet for orientation and one mandatory meeting during the summer for Interns' Progress report at CBC's summer BBQ event.
- 7. Must have reliable transportation to/from designated internship office.

### SBCC 2013-2014 Scholarship Applications Available



CBC's sister organization, South Bay Chinese Club (SBCC), now has their 2013-2014 scholarship e-application available.

The primary purpose of the South Bay Chinese Service Club is to award scholarships to graduating high school seniors of Chinese descent. Only students <u>residing in Fremont, Newark and Union</u> <u>City</u> or children of SBCC club members in good standing are eligible to apply. Eligible students and their parents may request the application forms by sending an email to <u>sbcc.scholarship@gmail.com</u> with "2013-2014 Scholarship Application Request" on the subject line and including the following information in the body of the email:

- 1) The student's full name and the city of residence
- 2) Name of High School currently attending
- 3) The email address to receive the application forms

Once the request email is received, the student can expect to receive the application file and the instructions within a couple of days. We will accept electronic version of the official transcripts as long as they are sent (emailed) directly from the school administration office. We will also accept electronic versions of the letter of recommendation.
