With this new beginning, I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself as the new South Bay Chinese Service Club Scholarship Committee Chairperson for 2021. As a proud former recipient from American High School, Class of 1980, and the proud mom of the Best Essay recipient from American High, Class of 2015, it gives me great pleasure to support South Bay Chinese Service Club's 51-year tradition of awarding scholarships to exemplary high school students of Chinese descent in our local community.

We look forward to receiving applications from children of club members and students residing in Fremont, Newark, and Union City, with the purpose of recognizing these talented students for their hard work and achievements, and to provide encouragement for the challenges ahead. Applicants are carefully evaluated based on academic achievement, leadership, community service, extracurricular activities, a personal essay on Chinese heritage, and financial need.

Last year, with generous donations from many of our club members, individuals, and community sponsors such as Fremont Bank, Republic Services, Dutra Enterprises, and Citizens for Better Community, we were able to award a total of \$24,500 in scholarships to 19 amazing high school seniors. This year, with your help, our goal is to extend our scholarship amount to serve even more students. The application request form can be found at our website: www.SouthBayChineseClub.org.

In the past, we have celebrated together at an Awards Banquet held at a local Chinese restaurant. This year, we will follow Alameda County health and safety mandates to see if we can present the scholarship awards at either an evening banquet, scheduled for Wednesday, May 19, 2021, or at an outdoor venue on the afternoon of Saturday, May 22, 2021, location to be determined. If we are still unable to gather safely in large groups, the awards will be presented at a virtual Zoom ceremony on Saturday, May 29, 2021. Our guests will include applicants, donors, former recipients, club members, school counselors, and local officials. Our very own community leader Ivy Wu, former Fremont Unified School Board Trustee, and founder of the Fremont Unified Student Store (F.U.S.S.), will be our special keynote speaker. This promises to be an exciting event, so please mark your calendars with these dates, and stay tuned for our updates!

The names of the donors will be included in our scholarship program and other printed materials, and donations of \$125 or more are entitled to complimentary dinners at our awards banquet, if held. Donations are tax-deductible, and your participation will send a powerful message about the strength of our community.
