## South Bay Chinese Service Club Annual Scholarship Banquet

On Wednesday, April 5, 2017, the South Bay Chinese Service Club (SBCSC) awarded \$25,000 in scholarships to graduating high school seniors of Chinese descent at the 48th annual SBCSC Scholarship Banquet held at the Union City Mayflower Restaurant. SBCC President Lorrice Wong greeted the graduates and praised them for their outstanding academic records and participation in community activities. Honored guests included Mayor of Fremont Lily Mei and Fremont City Council member David Bonaccorsi.

The graduating students and their parents were addressed by keynote speaker, Dr. Rita Ng, Chief of Cardiology at Kaiser Permanente in Oakland and Richmond. Dr. Ng completed her undergraduate studies at Stanford University and earned her medical degree from UCSF Medical School. In between



her undergraduate and graduate studies, Dr. Ng was crowned Miss California in 2000 and became the first person of Asian descent to be crowned Miss California in the 80-year history of the pageant.

In her speech, Dr. Ng shared with the students how she chose a different path from her original college career plan but still ended up attaining her goal to become a doctor, something she has wanted since she was 5 years old. She encouraged the graduating seniors to get out of their comfort zones and explore new interests while still pursuing their goals. She stressed the importance of leadership and urged the students to always remember their greatest source of encouragement and support: their families. As a cardiologist, she also advised that good health comes from making sensible food choices, not necessarily being on special diets but simply not indulging in unhealthy foods. It is OK to enjoy a birthday cake every now and then - just do not do it in excess.

Before the announcement of the scholarship award winners, all students received Certificates of Special Recognition from the following elected officials:

Edward Mora, representing U.S. Congressman Eric Swalwell; Sabrina Tamura, representing State Assembly member Kansen Chu; Erica Trask, representing Alameda County Supervisor Scott Haggerty; and Meriam Reynosa, representing State Senator Bob Wieckowski. Although unable to attend the banquet, U.S. Congressman Ro Khanna and State Assembly member Bill Quirk provided Certificates of Recognition ahead of time to be distributed to the students during the award ceremony.

The 18 scholarship winners this year is an impressive group of scholars representing 7 high schools in Fremont and Union City. Their average unweighted GPA is 3.8 and the average weighted GPA is 4.2. The Award recipients have taken a total of 241 AP classes and honor classes. Together they have amassed 6,422 community service hours. In this group, there are 4 National Merit Finalists, 11 AP Scholars, and 2 students with perfect unweighted 4.0 GPA's.

Plan now to see the Fremont July 4<sup>th</sup> parade! Even better, if you feel like being part of the parade this year, you are welcome to come and march too. We often hear Fremont citizens saying how much they look forward to seeing the Chinese Americans turn out. This year, Citizens for Better Community, South Bay Chinese Club, Friends of Children with Special Needs, CBC Toastmasters, and the Mandarin Immersion Program are already planning to join the parade. There will be several more as the day approaches.

Find your friends and join in the parade! It is fun and the length of the route is under a mile. The theme of this year's Fremont 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade is "We Are One."

To give you some background about the Fremont July 4th parades... this will be the 20th year of our city's parade. This year the parade will be held in Central Fremont with the same route as last year. We assemble at the Fremont Main Library and the parade route proceeds on Paseo Padre Parkway to Capitol Avenue. There are usually some 80 entries, including bands, drill and dance teams, floats, clowns, antique cars to name a few. Thousands of people will watch the star-spangled excitement of creative floats, specialty units, and marching musical units. Although the parade takes place on Tuesday, July 4, 2017, from 10 a.m. and ends by 12 noon, those who participate in the parade need to assemble by around 8:30 a.m. After our entry marches, please hang around a few minutes at the ending point to enjoy a cold treat refreshment with
